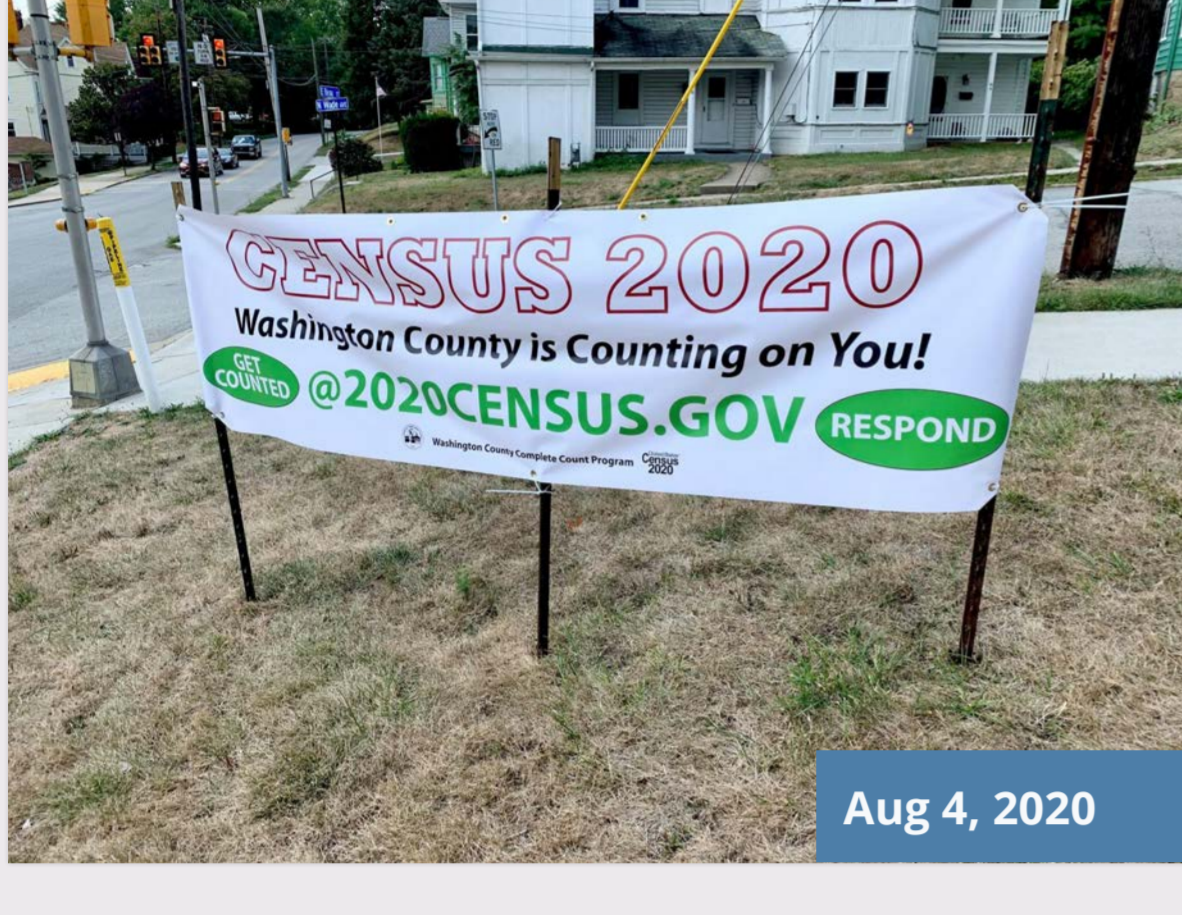
Welcome to Our Borough

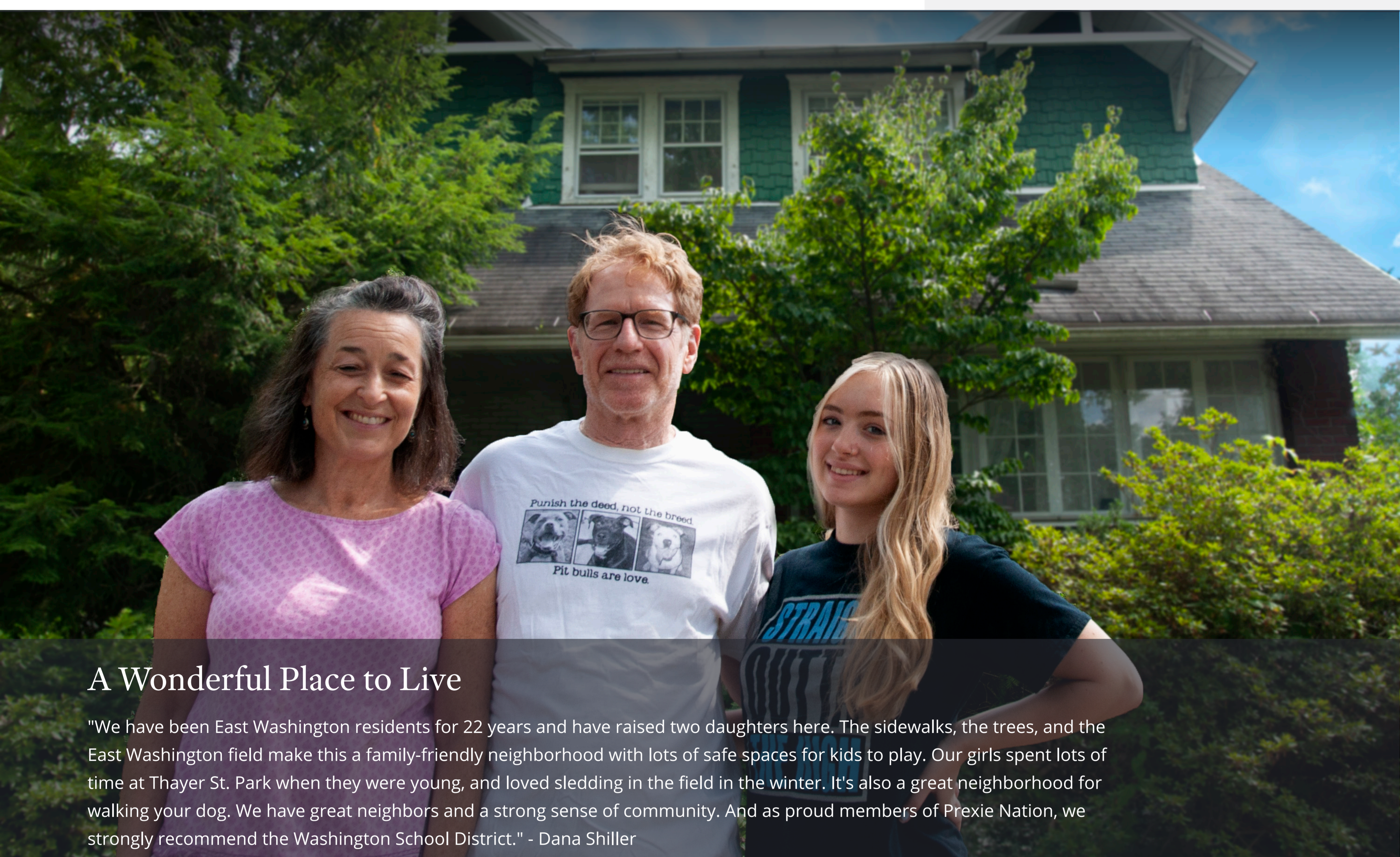

Our community boasts stately homes, many of which have achieved historic landmark status. Colorful gardens dot our tree lined streets.

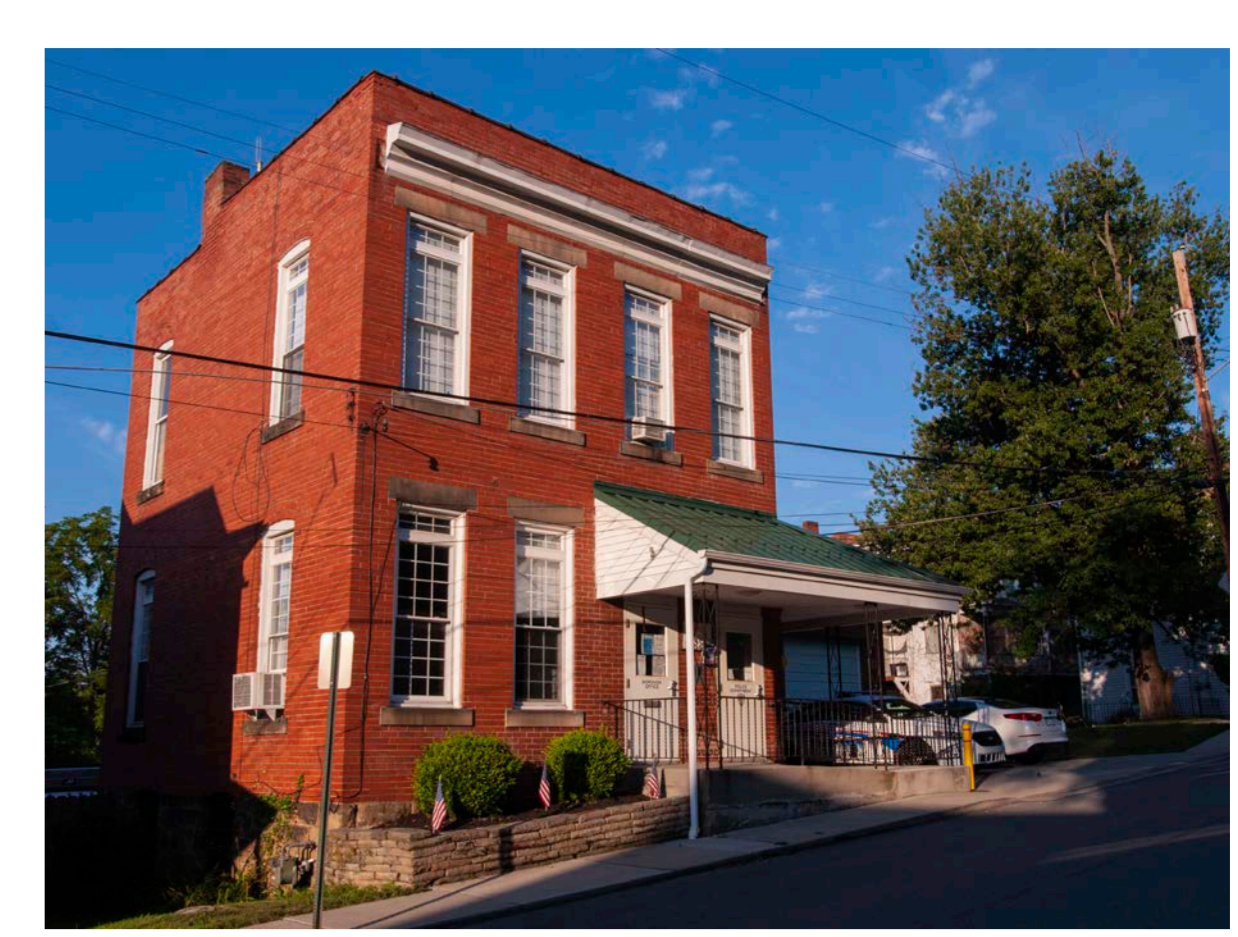

The prestigious Washington and Jefferson College, whose roots go back to the 1780's, is in our backyard. Citizens Library, a short walk away, is noted for its genealogical resources. The library was founded in 1870 by the noted abolitionist, Dr. Francis LeMoynes.

Our park and playground provide recreational spots. A wellness center and athletic training facility is within three miles of the Borough. The Elmhurst Swim Club is a beautiful and relaxing summer attraction.

The Washington Health System, with its 260 bed flagship hospital is within sight.

Other cultural resources within our community include the First Christian Church and the Beth Israel Synagogue, the lone Jewish temple in our county. Houses of worship of various denominations are located within the City of Washington.

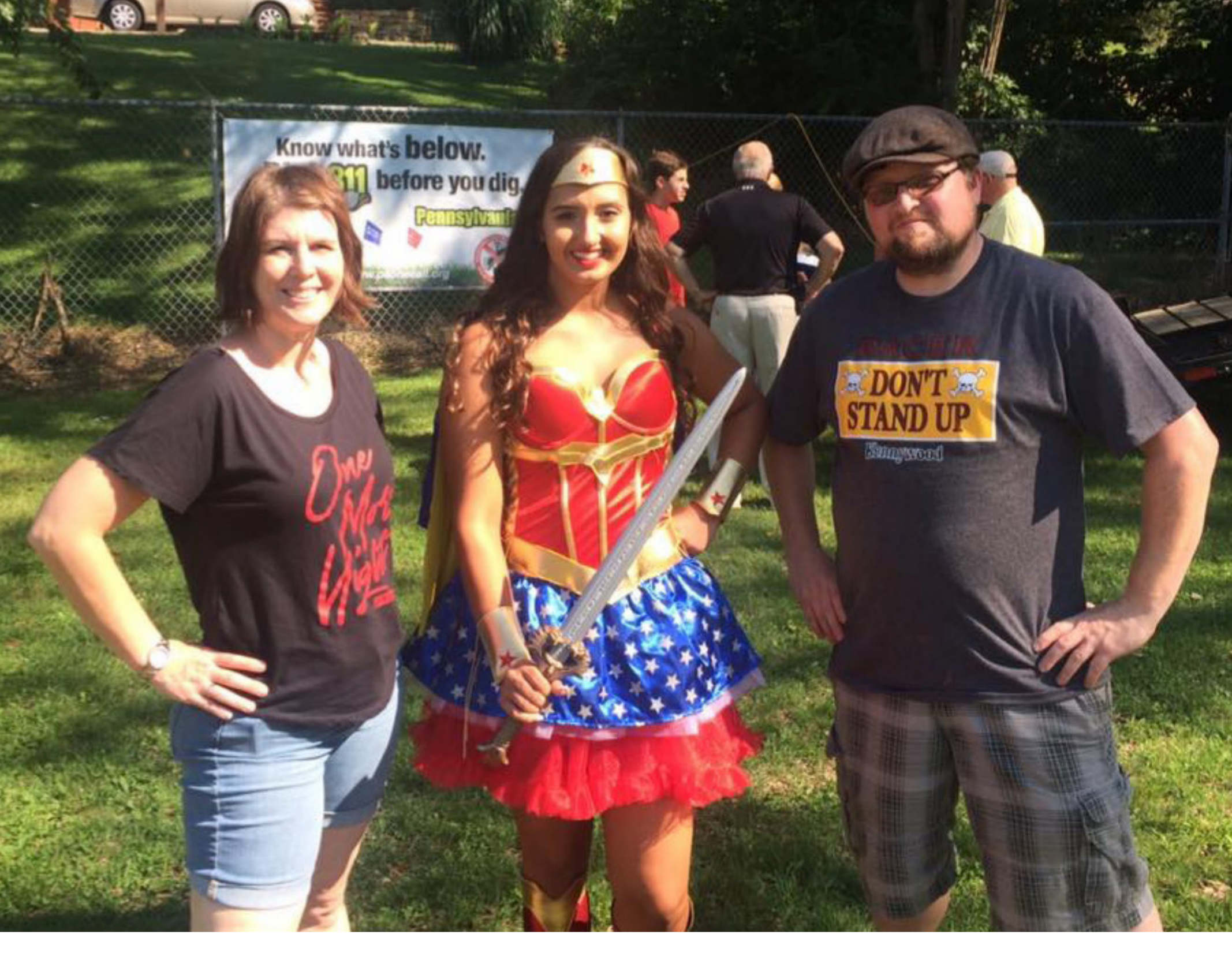
Thayer Street Park

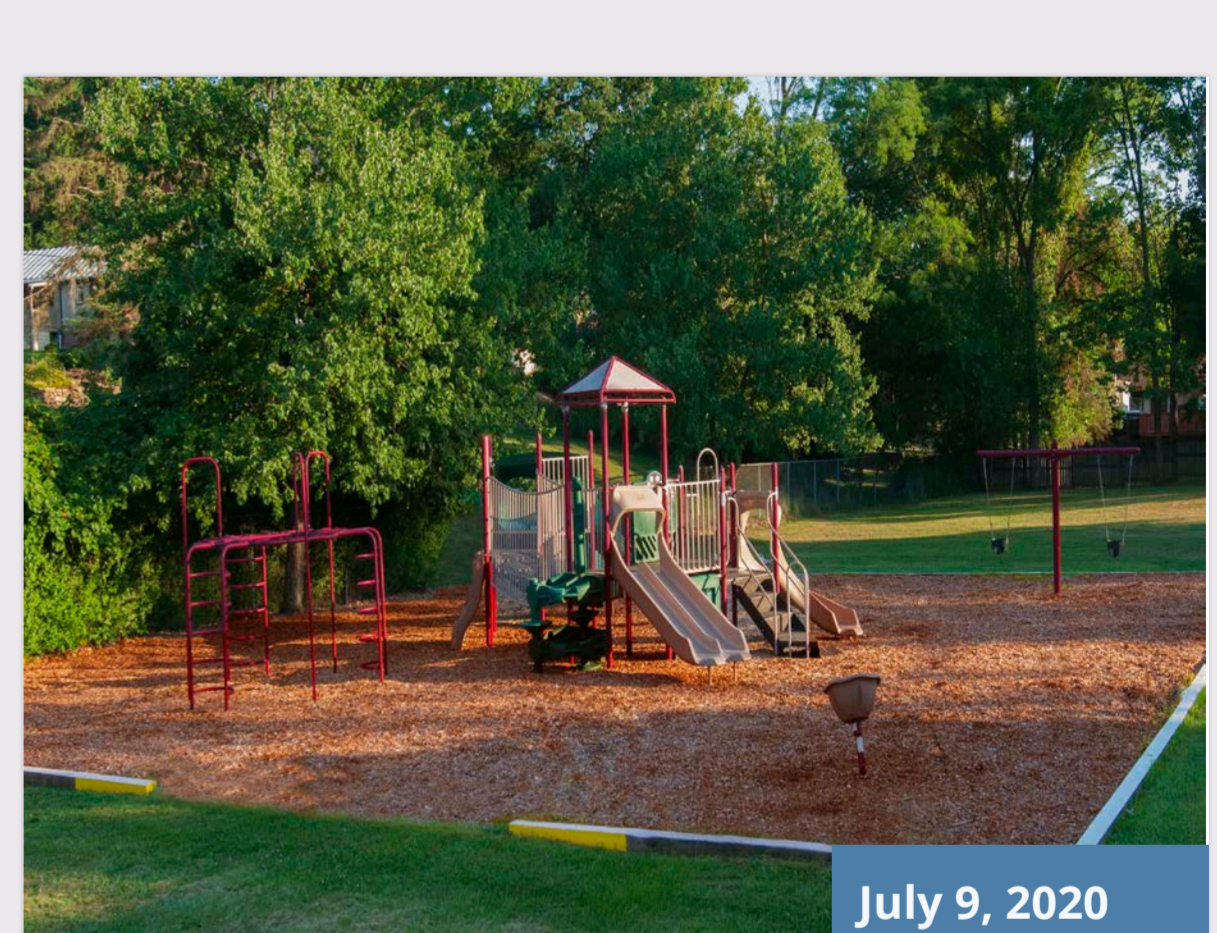
