- 2. A motion was made by Demond Nixon, seconded by Kent James to add Greenways, Trail grant (Playground program) to the agenda. Motion passed.

When asked to review the site plan and information for the Playground program, Council Member Michael McCormick gave a brief talk on some areas of consideration. He indicated that the drawings need more information, so we get the best gualified bidders. Discussions included 2 accessible parking spaces, 6 regular spaces. Tree removal, possible paving material concrete vs asphalt for longevity.
